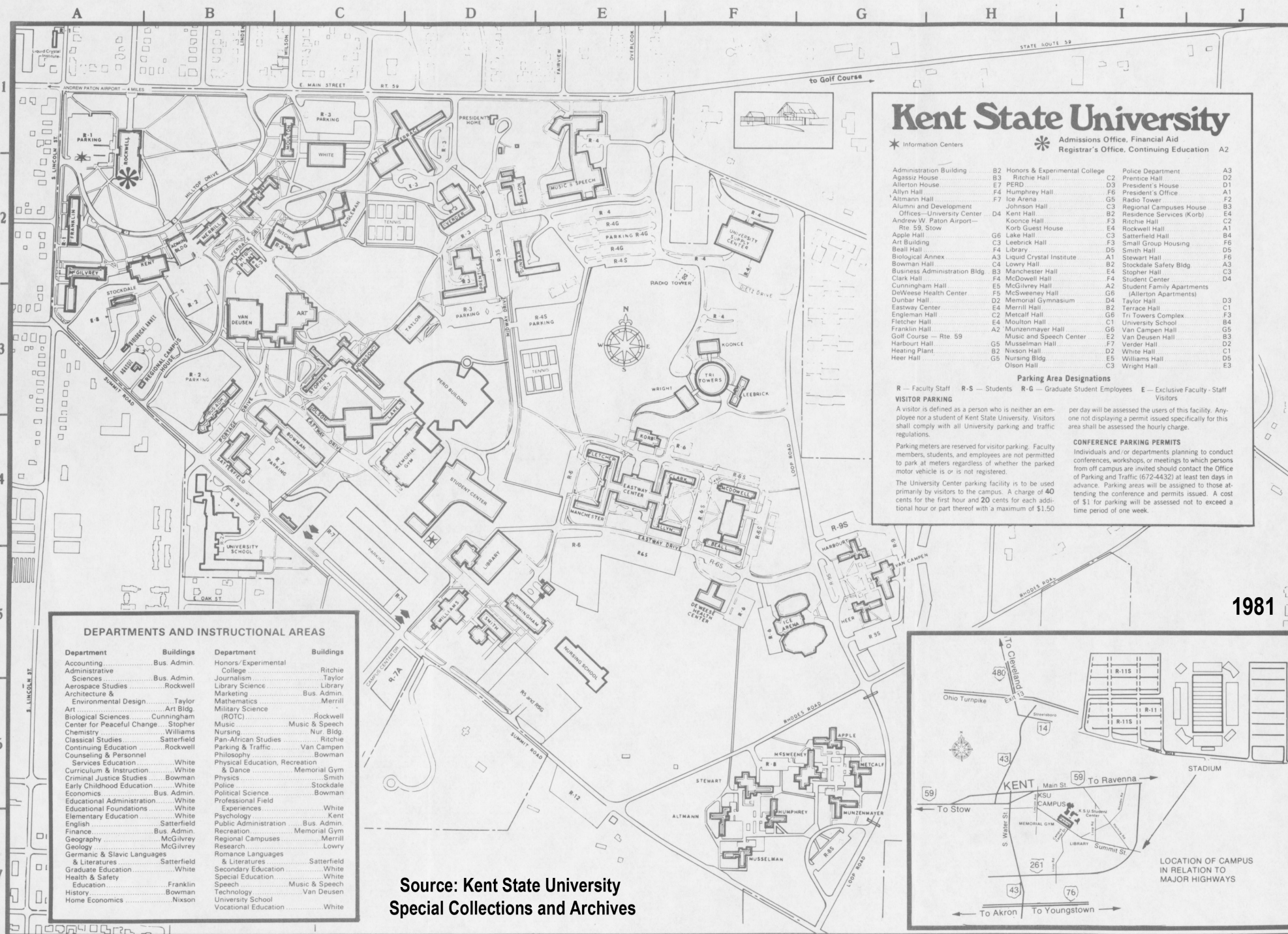

VISITOR PARKING

A visitor is defined as a person who is neither an employee nor a student of Kent State University. Visitors shall comply with all University parking and traffic regulations.

Parking meters are reserved for visitor parking. Faculty members, students, and employees are not permitted to park at meters regardless of whether the parked motor vehicle is or is not registered.

CONFERENCE PARKING PERMITS

Individuals and/or departments planning to conduct conferences, workshops, or meetings to which persons from off campus are invited should contact the Office of Parking and Traffic (672-4432) at least ten days in advance. Parking areas will be assigned to those attending the conference and permits issued. A cost of \$1 for parking will be assessed not to exceed a time period of one week.

The University Center parking facility is to be used primarily by visitors to the campus. A charge of 40 cents for the first hour and 20 cents for each additional hour or part thereof with a maximum of \$1.50
