

## University Libraries Waiver for Faculty Use of Student Materials for Reserve

According to Kent State University Policy, students own the copyright to works created as part of their coursework.<sup>1</sup> Instructors using student-created materials for reserve (electronic or print reserves) must have this waiver from completed and signed by both student and instructor. Signed waivers will be kept on file in the Reserve Services office. One form per student is required. Multiple works by one student may be listed on one form.
